Dear SBHEM Families,

District Policy regarding Halloween activities allow students to participate in enjoyable, positive, and controlled activities, while maintaining student safety. The following guidelines shall apply:

- Students may wear costumes to school according to guidelines established by the school.
- One of the most important mandates is that costumes shall not be demeaning to any person or group based on age, disability, ethnicity, gender, gender identity (boys as girls and vice versa), nationality, race, religion, sex, sexual orientation or to any individual staff or student at the school.
- Costumes may not cause a significant disruption or distraction to the school program such as revealing costumes (e.g., low cut, French maids, nightwear, and bathing suits).
- No costume can be worn that is unsafe or that may create a safety hazard.
- No weapons or replica weapons are to be brought to school.
- No masks are allowed that completely hide the identity of the student. No costumes are allowed that would impair a student's vision or movement (e.g., ability to climb stairs).

All restrictions and guidelines regarding obscene materials or prohibited substances remain in effect.

Estimadas familias de SBHEM,

Las reglas del distrito con respecto a las actividades de Halloween permiten a los estudiantes participar en actividades agradables, positivas y controladas, mientras se mantiene la seguridad de los estudiantes. Se aplicarán las siguientes reglas:

- Los estudiantes pueden usar disfraces para ir a la escuela de acuerdo con las pautas establecido por la escuela.
- Uno de los mandatos más importantes es que los disfraces no deben ser degradantes para ninguna persona o grupo por motivos de edad, discapacidad, etnia, género, identidad de género (niños como niñas y viceversa), nacionalidad, raza, religión, sexo, orientación sexual o para cualquier miembro individual del personal o estudiante de la escuela.
- Los disfraces no pueden causar una interrupción o distracción significativa al programa escolar, como disfraces reveladores (por ejemplo, corte bajo, sirvientas francesas, ropa de dormir y trajes de baño).
- No se puede usar ningún disfraz que sea inseguro o que pueda crear un peligro para la seguridad.
- No se deben traer armas ni réplicas de armas a la escuela.
- No se permiten máscaras que oculten completamente la identidad del estudiante. No se permiten disfraces que perjudiquen la visión o el movimiento de un estudiante (por ejemplo, la capacidad de subir escaleras).

Todas las restricciones y pautas con respecto a materiales obscenos o sustancias prohibidas permanecen vigentes.
